Lunch Club - £6.50

Admin Fee - £20.00 includes a free Pre-School polo shirt.

Please can any outstanding fees be paid as soon as possible; the second half of Autumn fees is payable on the 6th of November. Fees remain a significant percentage of our income and late payments can affect our cash flow. We are one of the few settings not making a separate charge for snacks or consumables, the free entitlement remains completely free for all families.

Regretfully, we can no longer guarantee a child's place if fees are outstanding. We are happy to negotiate a payment plan if that would be helpful, please speak to Janet Coleman in confidence



Please could you let us know if your child will be absent for any reason, particularly if you are in receipt of government funding. We are subject to auditing from the Local Authority and need to be able to justify any absences in the register with a note to say holiday or sickness, for example.

If we have not heard from you, we may telephone to ask why your child is absent, recent safeguarding training highlighted the importance of staying in touch with our families.

You do not need to email. (Mrs Coleman cannot access emails if she is in ratio) If it's easier, please leave a voicemail or a text message on our phone 07565000717 and it will be picked up when we arrive at 8.30.

Outdoor Play

As the weather gets colder, please send your child with a warm coat, hat and gloves. Please make sure that these items are named, you can order stick on name labels online. Please use the following information:

If your child comes in wellies, please can you also send indoor shoes or slippers, their feet get very hot and uncomfortable in wellies for a long period of time.

Pull Ups /Nappies

If your child is in the middle of toilet training, we understand that pullups provide a useful alternative to nappies. We can support this stage by taking your child to the toilet with other children and asking them to sit on the toilet or potty.

However, if your child is not ready for training, please could we ask that you send him/her in nappies. We find that pull ups do not hold as tightly and, if a child is soiled, it becomes quite messy and unpleasant for both him/her and the adult. It is also necessary to completely undress a child in order to put on a clean pull up - as you can imagine when we have 10 or so children requiring changing on a session, it can make the job rather time consuming.

It would be very helpful if you can ensure your child arrives in a fresh nappy, we are finding that the children need changing on arrival and this is the time that we need all staff in the hall to assist initial settling.

Carol Service & Nativity - Tuesday 19th December 11 am

We are very excited to invite you to our Carol Service and Nativity this year. The children will help us tell the story through song and drama in Church, led by Janet, Leslie and Tim. Please arrive in Church around 10.45 and take your seat.

Each child will have a role allocated and we will let you know if we need you to provide anything in terms of costume. If your child does not normally attend on Tuesday, he/she would be welcome to come in on the day and for the rehearsal the previous week, please speak to Sarah Howells or Janet Coleman to confirm.

The children will come into Church through the side door once you are all seated. Should your child become distressed we ask that you come and join us at the front rather than take them into the congregation. At the end of the service please remain seated and the children will leave via the side door. We will serve tea, coffee, and mince pies in Hall 2. If your child is not staying for lunch club and the afternoon, he/she can be collected from a member of staff in Hall 1 after you have finished your refreshments.

We will be taking a collection for Crackerjacks Children's Trust who support families who need specialised equipment and respite holidays.

Please do not take any photographs or make any recordings during the event, this is strictly against our safeguarding policy.

Photographs will be taken of the children in their costumes during the rehearsal and be made available for you afterwards.
